- Distilled Water
- Glycerin
- Glitter
- Mason Jar or Water Globe (must have a lid)
- Figurines or small toy
- Confetti
- Extra Strength Glue or Super Glue
- Acrylic Paint (to make your small toy waterproof if your object is not)

Pinecone Tree

- pinecone- preferably one that can sit upright
- green acrylic paint
- paint brush
- school glue
- thin wire (if making a garland for the tree)
- Optional items to decorate the tree (i.e. beads, pom poms, glitter, felt, more paint colors, etc.)

Glowing Snowman Magnets

- LED Tealight Candles
- Foam Craft Sheets
- Glue
- Thin Black Permanent Marker
- Magnets

Directions:



- 1. Pull the protective tab out of the battery compartment of each tealight candle.
- 2. Carefully glue a magnet to the back of the tealight, ensuring that glue does not make its way to the on/off switch.
- 3. Draw a snowman's face on the tea light with a black permanent marker. Cut out hats and scarves from the foam craft sheets and glue them to the tealight to complete the snowman's ensemble

- clear plastic ornament
- pom poms
- Gems

Directions
