

Do you want to try birding? Join a USFWS Bird Walk!

Who should participate? Naturalists of all ages who want hands-on education about north Texas birds.

When: The birders will meet on weekends at 8:45 AM and begin walking at 9. We will be birding for about an hour. Locations will be in DFW, and emailed out prior to meeting. Small groups or families can also bird by appointment.

Required: Children 18 and under must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. All participants must wear a mask. We will be social distancing. Bring water and snacks, if needed.

Optional: Bring bug spray, sunscreen, and a pencil if you would like. We will provide some binoculars, but if you have your own that's great! A smartphone or camera is also very useful for birding.
