

Many children are bitten and injured by dogs each year. Bites can result from family dogs, neighbor dogs, as well as strange dogs. These injuries often occur because children do not understand how to be safe around dogs.
"Don't Let the Dogs Bite: How to be Safe Around Dogs" can aid parents in teaching their children how to behave safely around dogs. After you read each page together, ask your child to explain the message presented in their own words. Consider presenting your child with a possible scenario involving the message on that page and have him respond (e.g.,"If you see a dog you don't know and want to pet it, what should you do?"). And, of course, be sure to let your child enjoy coloring the pictures, exploring the activities, and solving the puzzles.

We hope you enjoy reading and working through "Don't Let the Dogs Bite" with your child. You may learn something too!
