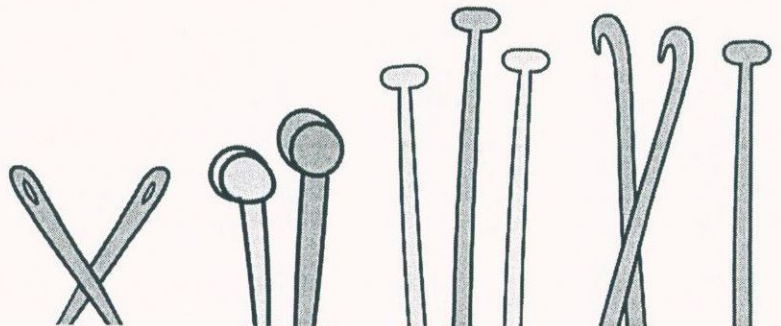
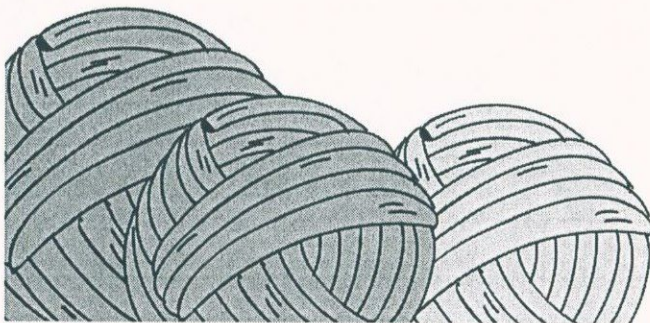


# *A Stitch in Time: Crochet Group*

The first project you will learn to crochet is a granny square lapghan

Necessary Supplies:

- 1 crochet hook size I (also referred to as a “9” or “5.5mm” hook)
- Medium weight acrylic yarn, #4 (you will find the number on the yarn label)
  - Pick one, two or three colors you like
  - You will need approximately 2100 to 2300 yards of yarn

Below are some of the more readily available yarns and how many skeins you will need:

- Red Heart Super Saver Solid—6 skeins (364 yards each)
- Caron One Pound—3 skeins (812 yards each)
- I Love This Yarn—6 skeins (355 yards each) only at Hobby Lobby
- Impeccable Solids —8 skeins (277 yards each)

You need not buy one of these if you find another yarn you like.

The yarns can be purchased at Michael’s, JoAnn Fabrics, Hobby Lobby or online. Not all stores carry all brands.

Bring your crochet hook and one skein of yarn to the first class!
